Section 1 Paragraph 1.A.15 be deleted and the remaining paragraphs renumbered
~~15. The final vote on the budget shall be by written ballot~~

Section 1 Paragraph 1.B.1.e.6 be amended by addition

All petitions submitted for consideration in a session of the annual conference must have a Presenter assigned to it by the submitter of the petition. The Presenter must be a member of the annual conference session in which the petition will be considered, and may present only one petition in that session unless the Petition Coordinating Committee grants an exception. Presenters shall be responsible for presenting the petition in the Legislative Committee to which the petition has been assigned and shall be available throughout the session as needed until the members of the annual conference make a final decision on the petition.

Section 1 Paragraph 1.C.1 be amended by deletion and addition to read

~~A petition presenter must be a member of the present annual conference session and can only present one petition.~~

Presenters who are unable to attend the Legislative Committee Session to which their petition has been assigned shall arrange for their own substitutes and shall inform the Chairperson of the Legislative Process of the change. Petitions without Presenters in the Legislative Committee shall be considered as not having been received by the annual conference legislative process.

Section 1 Paragraph 1.C.7.g be amended by deletion and addition to read

A petition becomes the property of the Annual Conference Session when it is stated by the chair of the Legislative Committee ~~in which it is considered~~ **to which it has been assigned.**
